This status is awarded based on a demonstrated commitment to ensuring that quarantine integrity is maintained through recognised contamination management strategies being implemented throughout the supply chain and continuing compliance with the requirements instigated and documented in the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service (AQIS) Site Audit Report of 30th July 2004.

This certificate is valid until 30th July 2007

Maintaining this status is dependent upon a satisfactory result in any annual third party audit undertaken during the currency of this certificate to confirm that the procedures, operations and pertinent infrastructure identified in the AQIS Site Audit Report of 30th July 2004 have not changed or that any changes do not impact on the ongoing quarantine integrity of the fertiliser. Third party auditors must be independently accredited and registered with an international auditing body.

It is the responsibility of Dead Sea Works to ensure that the procedures assessed in the AQIS Site Audit Report of 30th July 2004, are adhered to consistently and effectively, addressing critical control points identified by AQIS. This is a voluntary system of certification. Dead Sea Works may withdraw voluntarily. Certification may be revoked by AQIS for any reason and at any time.
